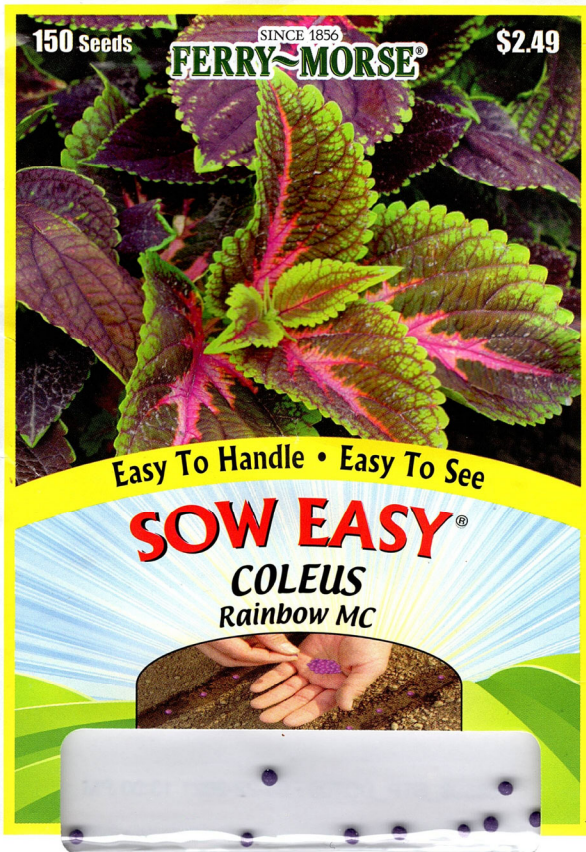

Perennial. For spring sowing, sow 8-10 weeks before last frost in deep seed-starting pots about ¼" deep, in rich, damp soil. Cover and refrigerate for 3-4 weeks. To germinate, move to a warm, well-lit spot, where seeds will pop within 20-45 days. Transplant after frost into an area in which plants can naturalize.

Instructions: For early bloom, start indoors 6 weeks before last frost. Transplant to garden after frost. Harden off before transplanting. Or, after danger of frost, sow outdoors in loose soil. Cover with 1/4 inch soil. Water lightly and frequently keeping the soil bed moist until the seeds germinate. Thin when plants are a few inches tall with the final spacing of the plants 10-12 inches apart. Garden Hints: Removal of faded blooms will lengthen the display.

SOW after danger of frost has passed, in rows 18" apart. Cover with 1/4" of fine soil. Firm lightly and keep evenly moist.

THIN seedlings to stand 12" apart when the plants are 1-2" high.

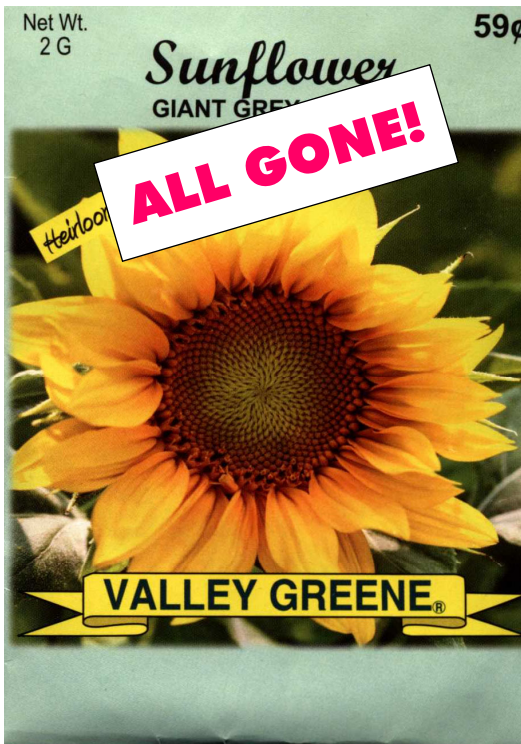
