Liatris require full sun and moist but well-drained soil. They tolerate a range of soil conditions, but perform best in slightly acidic, fertile soil.



## **Blazing Star**

200 seeds

Perennial. For spring sowing, sow 8-10 weeks before last frost in deep seed-starting pots about 1/4" deep, in rich, damp soil. Cover and refrigerate for 3-4 weeks. To germinate, move to a warm, well-lit spot, where seeds will pop within 20-45 days. Transplant after frost into

an area in which plants can naturalize.







#### 0292 - Love-Lies-Bleeding (Amaranthus caudatus)

Recorded in South America before the 16th century, often referred to as Inca Wheat. Grown for use as a cereal and in ancient religious ceremonies. Long red ropelike seed-bearing trusses give plants an ornamental and graceful appearance. Great for long-lasting displays. Tender annual, 3-4' tall.







(Nicotiana sylvestris)


