Seedy Facts

Store cut basil stems at room temperature in a jar of water. Use within several days for best quality.

Plant Preferences

Basil does not tolerate cold; it prefers full sun, and well-drained, moderately-fertile soil. Water at the base to keep plants healthy and dry. Moist conditions can bring on downy mildew.

Genovese Basil

250 seeds
65 days

Depth: ¼"
Plant spacing: 8"
Row spacing: 12"

Timing:
Start indoors 2-4 weeks before last frost. Transplant or direct sow after last frost.

For quality leaves all season, sow basil at monthly intervals until 60 days before first fall frost. Harvest often to prevent flowers from forming. To harvest, cut basil at the stem just above new leaf growth. Basil is very sensitive to the cold; harvest or protect plants if frost is imminent.

Date Seed Sown

Known as the Queen of Herbs in India, tulsi is considered to be sacred. This type of holy basil is also known as Kapoor, or temperate basil. It is distinguished by its bubble-gum scent, frost-tolerance, and fast-growing nature. Its health-promoting properties are said to help combat stress and other medical concerns. If allowed to flower, it is a bee magnet and it may reseed. Grow indoors for a continuous supply of fresh leaves throughout the winter. *This packet sows up to 72 feet.*

When to sow outside: 1 to 2 weeks after your average last frost date, and when soil temperature is at least 60°F, ideally 65°-85°F. **Successive Sowings:** We recommend 3 or 4 successive sowings every 3 weeks after initial sowing. **When to start inside:** RECOMMENDED. 4 to 6 weeks before transplanting outside. Transplant when your nighttime temperatures are above 50°F.

0462 - **Cumin** (*Cuminum cyminum*)

A native of Egypt, this low-growing annual rarely exceeds 6" in height. Cumin seeds are collected and used to flavor soups, stews, curry powder, and pastries and are also still employed in the manufacture of some liqueurs. Self-sowing annual.

Learn To Grow It

Start Indoors	Germination	Plant Outdoors	Light
6-8 Weeks before last frost	10-14 Days	4-8" Apart	Full Sun

Instructions- Seeds can be direct seeded 2-3 weeks after last frost when soil is warm. Alternatively, sow seeds indoors ¼" deep and transplant outdoors 2-3 weeks after last frost. Cumin thrives in well-drained, fertile soil and hot conditions.

Garlic Chives are very adaptable. They prefer some sun but will grow in fairly heavy shade. Weed carefully, as they look a lot like grass, especially in spring.

Garlic Chives

Timing:

Direct sow outdoors as soon as soil can be worked. Or, start seeds indoors 8-10 weeks before last frost.



Easy to grow, thriving in a number of garden places, including borders and containers. Transplant outdoors in clumps when 3" tall. Extremely hardy and fast growing once established. For best culinary quality, cut every week or two from mid-summer on.

0465 - **Sweet Marjoram** (*Origanum majorana*)

This fragrant herb is highly esteemed for a variety of seasoning needs. It is similar to oregano, but noticeably sweeter. The attractive 12-24" plants are dotted with small white flowers. Perennial in zones 6-8, grown as an annual in colder climates.

Learn To Grow It

Start Indoors	Germination	Plant Outdoors	Light
6-8 Weeks before last frost	10 Days	6-8" Apart	Full Sun

Instructions- Sow seeds indoors just beneath surface of soil. Transplant outdoors after danger of frost has passed. Plants prefer very well-drained soil.

1254 - **Sweet Mace** (*Tagetes lucida*)

Also known as Spanish Tarragon, Mexican Mint Marigold. Beautiful glossy leaves with small anise-scented golden flowers. The darling of many renowned Southwestern chefs, some even make a pesto from it! Plants grow 12-24" tall. Perennial in zones 8-11.

Learn To Grow It

Direct Seed	Germination	Thin	Light
1/8" Deep	4-10 Days	8-12" Apart	Full Sun

Instructions-Sow seeds outdoors two weeks before last frost. Can also be started indoors 6-8 weeks before last frost. Thrives in warm sunny areas with well-drained soil. May be used in place of tarragon.

1250 - Rosemary (*Rosmarinus officinalis*)

This attractive evergreen shrub, a Mediterranean native, produces grey-green pinnate leaves and thrives in containers. The classic herb has a spicy flavor and is used extensively to season meats and vegetables. Perennial in zones 7-10, it can be grown as an annual in the North or brought indoors for the winter.

Learn To Grow It			
Start Indoors 8-12 Weeks before last frost	Germination 14-21 Days	Plant Outdoors 12-24" Apart	Light Full Sun

Instructions- Sow seeds indoors 1/4" beneath surface of soil. Soil temperature should be kept above 70°F for germination. Plant out after danger of frost has passed in late spring. Prefers sandy, well-drained soil.

1253 - Spearmint (*Mentha sp.*)

The dark-green, toothed leaves of this mint species are used for making tea and cocktails and for flavoring candies and desserts, as well as for adding fragrance to lotions and tinctures. Perennial in zones 4-10.

Learn To Grow It			
Start Indoors 4-6 Weeks before last frost	Germination 7-10 Days	Plant Outdoors 12-18" Apart	Light Sun/Partial Shade

Instructions- Sow seeds indoors just beneath surface of soil. Transplant outdoors after danger of frost has passed in late spring. Can also be directly sown outdoors just before last spring frost. Spearmint will spread vigorously; to control its runners, plant in a container sunk into ground. Prefers average, well-drained soil and will tolerate dry conditions.

Plant Preferences

Parsley will grow in nearly any garden bed, in partial sun to full sun. Its preference is for well-drained soil.

Moss Curled Parsley

200 seeds
75 days

Depth: ¼"
Plant spacing: 8"
Row spacing: 18"

Timing:

Start indoors early and transplant, or direct sow as soon as ground can be worked. Can take up to 2 weeks to germinate.



Thin to 12" apart for bushier plants. Harvest continually by cutting off the outer stems, leaving the middle leaves to grow. One planting can last all season, but it can also be sown in early summer for a fresh fall-winter crop.
